



Perennial Ryegrass

Acappella comes from a broad genetic base of cultivars that have been widely adapted for a diverse geographical area and a multitude of turf applications. It performs well as a stand alone variety with its excellent seedling vigor and quick establishment, but it also blends well with other turf species and ryegrass varieties.

Acappella excels under various management regimes, including high maintenance fairway, high traffic areas, home lawns and athletic fields. **Acappella** is extremely dark green, very fine leafed and has excellent disease resistance.
