EARLY-MEDIUM HEADING

AMBA is a very winterhardy and thoroughly proven orchardgrass sold to many countries in the world where early abundant forage production is important. A key benefit of **AMBA** is that the digestibility is higher than many other early maturing orchardgrass varieties. **AMBA** is resistant to diseases such as Mastigosporium and rust. **AMBA** has the ability to tolerate hard night frosts after spring growth has started. **AMBA** has been trialed with good results in Kentucky and Wisconsin where it consistently outperforms older varieties such as Potomac.
