


## **TURFGRASS ZONES IN THE UNITED STATES**



**Cool Season Grasses:** Cool season grasses include Kentucky Bluegrass, Annual Ryegrass, Perennial Ryegrass, Colonial Bentgrass, Creeping Bentgrass, Tall Fescue, and Fine Fescue. These grasses survive best between 60-75 degrees Fahrenheit, can tolerate long winter dormancy, and have the best shoot growth during the spring and the fall.

**Transition Zone:** Both warm season grasses and cool season grasses have a possibility for growth in the Transition Zone.

Warm Season Grasses: Warm season grasses include St. Augustine, Bermudagrass, Zoysiagrass, Manilagrass, and Centipede Grass. These grasses survive best between 80-95 degrees Fahrenheit, are intolerant to extended cold periods, and have the best shoot growth during the summer.
